Avant Gardeners

The Avant Gardeners share a passion for gardening and share in activities that are all things gardening. Meetings have included guest speakers who are experts in specific areas of gardening such as a certified rosarian, a flower tower expert, and more. They are constantly adding new activities, such as garden walks in Compass Pointe, plant swaps, herb gardening, and a visit from a county extension agent.

Benevolence

This group provides opportunities for Compass Pointe owners to volunteer for projects supporting those in need in the local community. Meetings are held the first Wednesday of every month.

Biking

The Biking Club is a group of residents who share a love of cycling – from casual community rides to longer rides in the greater Wilmington area.

Bocce

This ancient Roman pastime is now a regular activity at Compass Pointe. Bocce is played with eight large balls and one smaller target, or object ball, called a pallino. The Bocce Club plays every Sunday on the Great Lawn in front of the Grand Lanai at 4:00 pm. Bring your Bocce set if you have one, as well as beverages and appetizers to share, and become part of the fun.

Book

There are bookworms at Compass Pointe! The Afternoon Book Club meets the 2nd Wednesday of the month, 3:30 - 5:30 pm. The Evening Book Club Meetings are hosted by members in their homes on the 4th Wednesday of the month, 7:00 - 9:00 pm.

Bowling

Compass Pointe Bowling leagues are for those who want to have fun bowling and include all skill levels. The leagues are in the spring and fall, 14-16 week sessions. Meetings/games are weekly, held on Mondays at either 12 noon or 6:30 pm at Cardinal Lanes on Shipyard Boulevard.

Bridge

The Bridge Club is for those with a basic knowledge of Bridge, using Goren principles, who want to play socially and have fun. Meetings are monthly, on the 3rd Tuesday of the month, at 7:00 pm. Members rotate hosting each month.

Bunco

Modern Bunco is a parlor game generally played with twelve or more players, divided into groups of four, trying to score points while taking turns rolling three dice. Come join the fun!

Canasta

Canasta is a fun and challenging card game, derived from Rummy, that requires strategy and teamwork in groups of four. Club meets every Tuesday at 1:00 pm in the Grand Lanai or Community Room.



Canine and Friends

The Canine and Friends Club strives to improve the experience for canines and their owners in Compass Pointe. This club educates through training techniques for canines, entertains with “play dates,” and shares in pet sitting services.

Cribbage

Cribbage, or crib, is a card game that is traditionally for two players but can include several players. It involves grouping cards in combinations to gain points. Cribbage has several distinctive features: the cribbage board used for score keeping, the eponymous crib or box, two distinct scoring stages, and a unique scoring system. This group gets together regularly for some competitive fun!



Culinary

Calling all cooks! This club celebrates the art of cooking by hosting multiple dining events for the community, which has been a great time for residents to socialize and develop new friendships. Members trade recipes and techniques and enjoy sharing prepared meals together, as well as providing for neighbors at The Grand Lanai.

Day Trips & Travel

The Day Trips & Travel Club enjoys getting together to explore the area in Wilmington and Brunswick County at least once per month, as well as planning for longer trips outside the local area.

Fishing

The Fishing Club gathers monthly to share tactics, listen to advice from experts, and tell tales of “the one that got away”. In addition, they plan chartered fishing trips, and fish together from the area’s many piers and/or surf.



Golf

Compass Pointe has several golf clubs including: The Compass Pointe Men’s Golf Association, Original Men’s Local Play, Ladies of The Pointe, Odd Couples Golf, and Nine & Dine. Anyone can be a member of multiple clubs. All the clubs are to encourage fun golf play, etiquette, and good sportsmanship.

Hot Stove Baseball League

The Compass Pointe Hot Stove League (CPHSL) is for members to demonstrate and pursue their passion for the game. Bi-weekly meetings allow for discussion of “all things” baseball, including the current state of the game, its history, and its players, past and present. The club attends baseball games in Wilmington, Myrtle Beach, and other places in the area.

Knit, Crochet & Hand Work

If you love knitting, sewing, quilting, cross stitching, embroidery, or any other type of hand crafting, this club is for you! Crafters of all skill and experience levels are welcome.
